

CLEANING AND CARE OF PLEATED SHADES



INSTRUCTIONS

CLEANING AND CARE:

Shades should be kept in the closed / up position when not in use. This will help maintain the pleat retention and minimize dirt and soil build-up. Do not store the shades in the open / down position as it may cause the shade to lose pleat retention if the shades are not operated on a consistent basis.

Shades can easily be cared for by simply dusting or using a vacuum cleaner attachment. Do not use spot remover, household cleaners or detergents to remove soiled spots. In doing so, it could cause the fabric to become damaged or faded. Dry cleaning foams are recommended but please try it on a small area to test and consult the foam directions.

NOTE: IF YOUR RECREATIONAL VEHICLE MUST BE STORED FOR AN EXTENDED PERIOD OF TIME, STORE THE SHADES IN THE UP POSITION AND COVER YOUR WINDOWS WITH ADDITIONAL PROTECTION (I.E. CUT OUT CARDBOARD)
